DUTIES OF SEC. TARBIYYAT

- 1. Familiarise the members with the teachings of Islam and Ahmadiyyat.
- 2. See members observe the *basics of their faith*:
 - a. Daily prayers;
 - b. Fasting during Ramadan;
 - c. Payment of Zakat;
 - d. Performance of Hajj;
 - e. Attend the Friday Prayer;
 - f. Members inculcate the habit of honest and fair dealings;
 - g. Eradicate un-Islamic practices, if any.
- 3. Look after members religious education and training; May adopt following means:
 - a. Arrange Dars of the following:
 - (1) Holy Quran;
 - (2) The Hadith
 - (3) Books and Malfozat of Hazrat Masih Mau'ud (Peace be upon him)
 - b. Arrange lectures, seminars and Tarbiyyat Classes for moral and spiritual training of the children, the youth and the elders of the Jama'at;
 - c. Motivate members of the Jama'at that they regularly listen Friday Sermons;
 - d. Publish leaflets and pamphlets for this purpose;
 - e. Personally contact the less active members;
 - f. Give publicity to the moral teachings of Islam;
 - g. Continuously make assessment of the state of Tarbiyyat of members of the Jama'at with respect to the fundamentals of Islam and adopt appropriate measures for this purpose.
- 4. See Nau Muba'in receive proper Tarbiyyat and they are informed of their obligations and responsibilities as Ahmadis.
- 5. Motivate female members of the Jama'at to observe *Purdah* (Veil) and enlist the help of Lajna Imaillah and family heads for this purpose;
- 6. Continuously remind the members of the Jama'at to develop habit of praying to Allah.
- 7. Educate members about the importance of Nizam Khilafat and train the Jama'at to always uphold the institution of Khilafat and always obey Hadrat Khalifatul Masih.
